

Peter Pan Playgroup Earrings and Piercings Policy

Peter Pan Playgroup believes in the inclusion of all children and that their personal safety is paramount. Therefore, it is not recommended that earring or jewellery in piercings to be worn by a child whilst that child is attending Playgroup.

If a parent or legal guardian decides it is paramount for the child to wear earrings or jewellery in piercings, these must be of a small stud type and preferably covered by medical tape prior to the child attending Playgroup.

It is requested that the parent or guardian of any child wearing earrings or jewellery in piercings complete the following:

I,

Being the parent of legal guardian of my child

hereby accept full responsibility for any injury caused to said child because of or the consequence upon the wearing of earrings or jewellery in piercings by my child. The term earrings include any object worn by being attached to any part of the ear.

I have had brought to my attention the dangers of my child wearing earrings or jewellery in piercings at Playgroup and realise that even under the most careful supervision, there is the risk of the earring being caught and the ear lobe being badly torn and other injuries dependent upon the location of the piercing.
